

DOs & DON'Ts in your apartment – to prevent unnecessary expenses, use this list

- Throw out junk mail – Do not leave them in the hallway. In the backyard there are containers specifically for recycling of paper and also material made of glass. If you do not wish to receive the Danish commercials and free newspapers you can get sticker for your mail box saying “No thank you” at the nearest Post office.
- All imported food should be kept in air tight boxes and no open containers with food kept outside the fridge. This is to prevent bugs and cockroaches.
- Open at least two windows for half an hour every day. This is to prevent mildew, fungus and bad environment indoor. If you have a window in the bathroom, please open it after showering. Especially in winter time when the difference between indoor and outdoor temperature varies, this is important.
- In Denmark we have a lot of calcium in the water. The tap water is drinkable but can leave stains of lime scale in sink and shower, which can lead to permanent damage if not being removed on regular basis; Always wipe the bathroom floors and tabletops for water, clean bathroom and kitchen sink with special cleaning detergents for the lime scale = Anti Kalk.
- Always use bed linens for duvets and pillows and sheets for the beds. The bedcovers are only meant to be used as a part of the decoration of the bedrooms, not as alternative to duvets.
- Do not put stickers or anything else on walls, cupboards etc. if they cannot be removed without a trace.
- In general we kindly ask you to take good care of our items so the next tenants will be just as happy as you are when moving in! Thank you in advance.
